

JANUARY 2002 CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE

BILL NO. CLB0207

INTRODUCED BY: MIKE NOT AFRAID, BLACK LODGE DISTRICT

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: AN ACT ESTABLISHING A TRIBAL MOTOR POOL DEPARTMENT WITHIN THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH TO PROMULGATE AND ENFORCE POLICIES AND PROCEDURES CONSISTENT WITH THE ENABLING ACT AND THE CROW CONSTITUTION.

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribe of Indians owns in excess of fifty (50) vehicles purchased with Crow Tribal funds which have been utilized by the Crow Tribal Officials and other employees of the Crow Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Legislative Branch of the Crow Tribe, in an effort to abide by the equal protection requirements of the Crow Tribal Constitution and to protect the limited resources of the Crow Tribe, desire to establish a motor pool of only the number of vehicles necessary to conduct official Tribal business for use by the Crow Tribal Executive (including employees) and Legislative Branches and to dispose of excess vehicles in a fair and profitable manner; and

WHEREAS, the Executive and Legislative Branches of the Crow Tribe resolve that the number of vehicles owned by the Crow Tribe necessary for official Tribal business shall be placed into motor pool for use by the Executive (including employees) and Legislative Branches on a checkout and return basis; and

WHEREAS, the Legislative Branch of the Crow Tribe realizes the necessity to promulgate and enforce policies and procedures consistent with this intent and the Crow Tribal Constitution to regulate the operation of the Crow Tribal Motor Pool; and including Crow Tribal property

WHEREAS, there currently exists no body within the Crow Tribal Government directly responsible for the maintenance of a Tribal Motor Pool, or for the promulgation and enforcement of policies and procedures necessary for the regulation of such motor pool.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE CROW TRIBE:

NEW SECTION. Section 1. Crow Tribal Motor Pool Department Established. (1)
The Crow Tribal Motor Pool Department is hereby established as a department in the Executive Branch of Government and as such, shall have the direction of the Chief Executive Officer of the Tribe. This office shall have the duties of establishing and maintaining a pool of all tribally owned vehicles. Further, this office shall be responsible for promulgating and enforcing policies and procedures for the use of such pool, consistent with the Crow Tribal Constitution.



NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an integral part of Title _____, Chapter _____, Part _____, and the provisions of Title _____, Chapter _____, Part _____ apply to [section 1].


