LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION NO. LR08-12

INTRODUCED BY: SENATOR BEVERLY M. SHANE, MIGHTY FEW DISTRICT
LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION OF THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE ENTITLED:

**“RETRO COMPENSATION OF ADMINISTRATIVE LEAVE FOR 2008
QUARTERLY/SPECIAL SESSIONS AND ESTABLISHING ADMINISTRATIVE
LEAVE WITH PAY PER-EMPLOYEE AFTER QUARTERLY/SPECIAL
SESSIONS”.**

WHEREAS, The Crow Tribal Legislature is authorized to adopt resolutions, regulations and guidelines for the governance of the Crow Tribe of Indians, pursuant to Article V, Section 2(a) of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Crow Tribe of Indians, approved by the Secretary of the Interior on December 04th 2001; and

WHEREAS, The Crow Tribal Legislature finds it in the best interest of the staff of the Crow Tribal Legislature be compensated for 2008 Quarterly/Special sessions, by awarding three (3) administrative leave days per Quarterly/Special sessions convened in 2008; and


WHEREAS, The staff play a key role working for the branch and present themselves in a well profound manner, and

WHEREAS, To award the Crow Tribal Legislative staff for their hard work ethics and efforts during Quarterly/Special sessions, and

WHEREAS, the Crow Tribal Legislature would like to award it's staff three (3) administrative leave days with pay per-employee after each Quarterly/ Special Session hereafter, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE.

FURTHER, THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE HEREBY THIS ACTION OFFICIALLY COMPENSATE THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATIVE STAFF BY AWARDING THREE (3) ADMINISTRATIVE LEAVE DAYS PER-EMPLOYEE, PER-SESSIONS CONVENED IN 2008, AND

FINALLY, THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE GRANTS THE STAFF THREE (3) ADMINISTRATIVE LEAVE DAYS FOR QUARTERLY SESSIONS AND ONE (1) ADMINSTRATIVE LEAVE DAY FOR SPECIAL SESSIONS WITH PAY PER-EMPLOYEE FOR EACH QUARTERLY/SPECIAL SESSION HEREAFTER.


