**CHAP. 265.**—An Act To amend the Act of Congress approved May 29, 1928, authorizing the Secretary of the Treasury to accept title to certain real estate, subject to a reservation of mineral rights in favor of the Blackfeet Tribe of Indians.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,* That the Act of Congress approved May 29, 1928, is hereby amended so as to authorize the Secretary of the Treasury to accept title to a tract of land containing approximately forty-two and ninety-five one-hundredths acres, being a portion of the proposed inspection station at Babb-Piegán, Montana, subject to a reservation of mineral rights in favor of the Blackfeet Tribe of Indians provided for in the Act of Congress approved June 30, 1919 (Forty-first Statutes, page 17).
