LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION NO. LR0206

INTRODUCED BY: MIKE NOT AFRAID, BLACK LODGE DISTRICT

A RESOLUTION OF THE LEGISLATIVE BRANCH OF THE CROW TRIBAL GOVERNMENT

A RESOLUTION TO REQUEST BIA TO REVIEW ALL LEASES ON THE PRYOR CREEK AND KRONE RANCHES TO DETERMINE WHETHER THEY ARE IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE TRIBE ECONOMICALLY FURTHER, SHOULD BIA FIND THAT THE CURRENT LEASES ARE NOT IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE TRIBE, THAT THE BIA TAKE AFFIRMATIVE ACTION IN CANCELING THE LEASES AND RE-LEASE THE LAND TO TRIBAL MEMBERS.

WHEREAS, the Krone Ranch and the Pryor Creek Ranch are valuable assets of the Crow Tribe; and

WHEREAS, these ranches are a great potential sources of lease income for the Crow Tribe; and


WHEREAS, the Legislative Branch of the Crow Tribe believes that it is in the best interest of the Tribe that these lands be leased by Crow Tribal members.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE CROW TRIBE:

That the BIA must review the Pryor Creek and Krone Ranch leases to determine whether they are presently in the economical best interest of the Crow Tribe. Further, if the leases are not in the best interest of the Tribe, the BIA should cancel the current leases and re-lease them to Tribal members.
