

CHAP. 25.—An act to amend the act entitled “An act to provide for the removal of the Flathead and other Indians from the Bitterroot Valley, in the Territory of Montana,” approved June fifth, eighteen hundred and seventy-two. Feb. 11, 1874.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the time of sale and payment of pre-empted lands in the Bitterroot Valley, in the Territory of Montana, is hereby extended for the period of two years from the expiration of the time allotted in the act entitled “An act to provide for the removal of the Flathead and other Indians from the Bitterroot Valley, in the Territory of Moutana,” approved June fifth, eighteen hundred and seventy-two. Sale of lands in
Bitterroot Valley.
Time extended.

SEC. 2. That the benefit of the homestead act is hereby extended to all the settlers on said lands who may desire to take advantage of the same. Homestead act
extended to settlers.
